Guidelines for filling of the log book

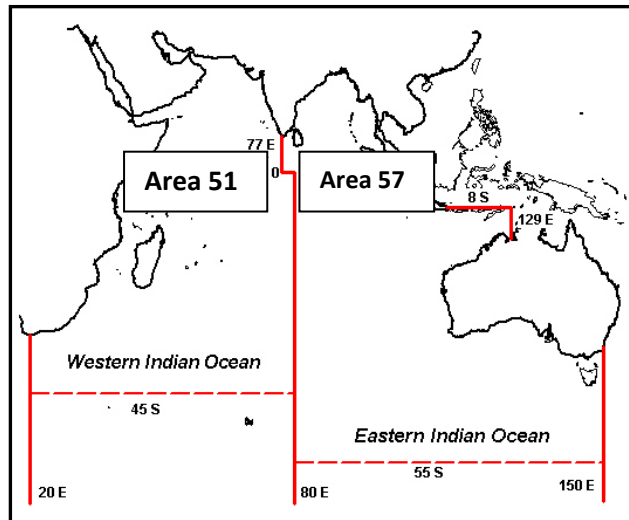
1. Voyage summary

Fishing gear configuration:

1. Main line length: Straight length of main line between successive branch lines.
2. Branch line length: Straight length between snaps and hooks.
3. Float line length: Straight length from the float to the snap.
4. The number of hooks between floats: if different number of hooks between floats were used, the most representative one may be recorded.

Area of operation

1. See the figure below for definition of FAO areas 51 and 57. The area of operation may be marked accordingly. If operated in both the areas, tick mark area 51 and area 57.
2. If fishing was done within the Indian EEZ only, tick marks "EEZ only". If operated outside the EEZ also, tick mark "EEZ and High Seas".



2. Catch Details

Any other species may be indicated below the listed species.

3. Set wise Details

SST: Sea Surface Temperature at noon with one decimal point, if available (XX.X °C)

Other Details

1. Turtles: Please indicate species in the remarks column
2. Discard: Please indicate species in the remarks column
3. Predation: Please indicate species and no. of fish predated. To designate the species, the following abbreviations may be used.

YFT= Yellow fin Tuna

BET= Big eye Tuna

SKJ= Skipjack Tuna

SWO= Sword fish

MLS= Striped Marlin

BLZ= Blue Marlin

BLM= Black Marlin
